## **An Outstanding Historic Royal Park!**

Richmond Park is London's largest
Royal Park and the largest urban
park in Europe and is designated
as a "Site of Special Scientific
Interest" and a National Nature
Reserve.

Richmond Park was established in its present form in 1625 by
Charles I, turning the area on the hill above his relocated palace in Richmond into a hunting park for red and fallow deer.





## Richmond Park - Ideal for Biking!

Richmond Park is large and offers tens of kilometres of traffic free shared trails through the parks natural and wild habitats.



## The latest bikes & equipment

Our bike of choice is the Trek Marlin 5 mountain bike.

The bike comes with disc brakes and is geared in order to enable riders to easily navigate the hills and undulations of Richmond Park! We also provide free helmets to all.

We also have road, hybrid and a small number of tandem bikes too!

### Things to see and do!

With a number of places of interest and places to eat and drink it is easy to plan a full day of activities in Richmond Park. **Isabella Plantation** - An ornamental woodland garden, full of exotic plants; Pembroke Lodge - A beautiful Georgian mansion set in 13 acres of landscaped grounds with spectacular view. Pen Ponds -Pen Ponds are more or less in the centre of the park and was created in 1746. It is a great place to see water birds as it is a lake divided in two by a causeway. Cafes and refreshments can be found at Pembroke Lodge, Roehampton Car Park.

## **Keeping Safe**

- We recommend everyone wears a cycling helmet; we can provide helmets for free.
- Many of the trails are shared so you need **to** let pedestrians know you are there with a **bell** or a polite greeting and *give way*.
- Keep to the trails speed limit of **10 mph** (fines may be given by the police!)
- Take care if you descend **Broomfield Hill**; most accidents occur here so we advise always ascending it rather than descending
- All **children** in baby seats/trailers **must be secured as ALL TIMES** with the safety straps
- Children must wear helmets at all times when using baby seats or tag-alongs

### The Rules

There are a few rules that you are must follow as part of the terms of hire.

- Adhere to the rules of the Parkcycle and the Royal Parks
- Please follow all reasonable written and verbal instructions and warnings given by the Parkcycle for staff
- You must not behave in a way which
  disrupts the safety or enjoyment of
  others; offensive, irresponsible or unsafe
  behaviour, theft or vandalism, will not be
  tolerated
- Stay inside the park boundaries;
- DO NOT SKID the bikes!!!



You must keep to the designated routes

Cycling on the grass is strictly prohibited

### **Your Arrival**

As you will be a larger group your organiser should ensure you <u>arrive in good time\*</u> in order to begin your hire on time;

### We need to:-

- Find the correct sized bike for you
- Carry out a final safety check on the bike we are giving you
- Explain the use of the gears and brakes to you
- Give you safety and route planning information
- Record the bike number for our booking system



\*\* Large Groups should arrive at least 15-30 minutes ahead of their booking time by arrangement



## We will look after you!

Whilst we check each bike before allocation once you have your bike please take it on a short test ride to make sure that:-



- You are happy with the sizing and the height of the saddle
- That there are no issues with the brakes, gears or handling of the bike
- That the tyres are inflated correctly



Vehicle Access - The Royal Parks have three measures in place: -

- · No through traffic between Broomfield Hill Car Park and Robin Hood Car Park
- A permanent closure of the vehicle link between Sheen Gate and Sheen Cross
- On weekends and public holidays, a restriction on all cut-through traffic between Roehampton and Richmond Gates
